Aloha,

With positive momentum behind the development of the cultural hub, we humbly request your support in our November Charity Golf. Attached are the forms. Our goal is to exceed a net of \$100,000, that is beyond the net of last November's tournament of \$70,000.

Eight years ago, the Japanese Cultural Center of Kona was organized with a vision of building a much-needed social infrastructure on the Island of Hawaii. We are nearing acquisition of an ideal 50acre parcel for the planned 30acre Center in the heart of Kailua Kona. Your contribution will be applied to the \$4M purchase price of the 50acre lot.

A consultant is currently engaged to develop a site-specific master plan and soon an archeologist will be engaged to perform the Archeological Inventory Survey. Experienced consultants have developed action and budget plans to develop the Center once the parcel has been purchased. Moreover, a long-term sustainable plan has been developed as well.

Imagine, the planned 5-star concert half could accommodate internationally acclaimed performers that will elevate the Big Island as a world class destination. The ballrooms could be utilized by the community with convenient parking for over 500 vehicles. How about locals and visitors enjoying a peaceful and tranquil time at the Japanese Gardens.
